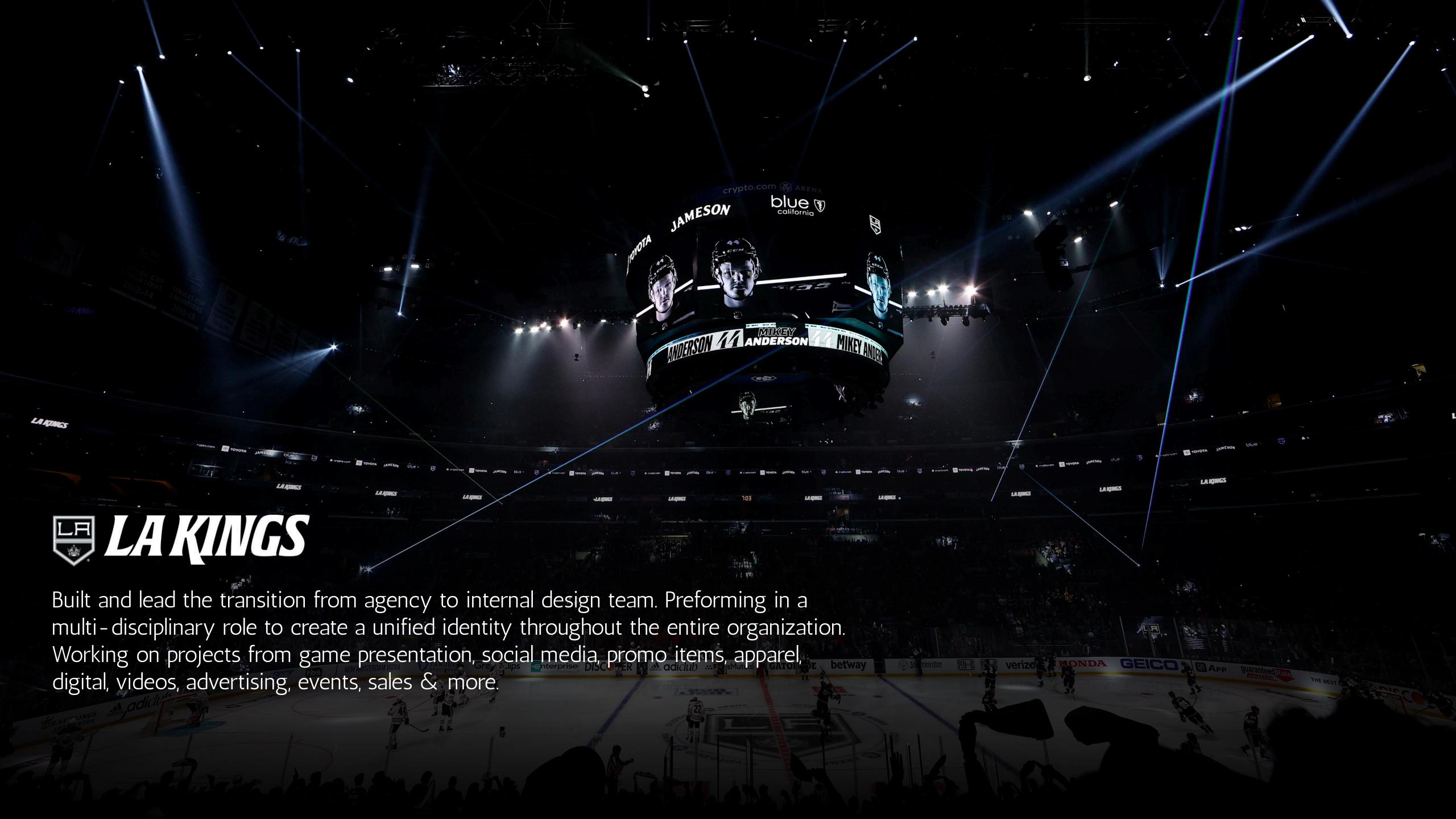

Creative direction, design and layout, photo retouching and comping. Developing breakouts, creating toolkits assets for use through season. Pre-press and production for delivery to printers.

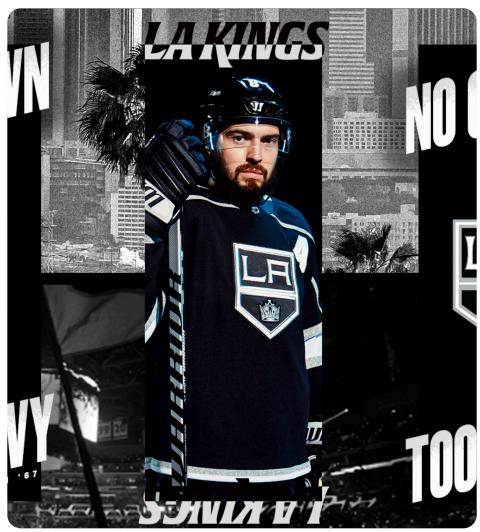
Results

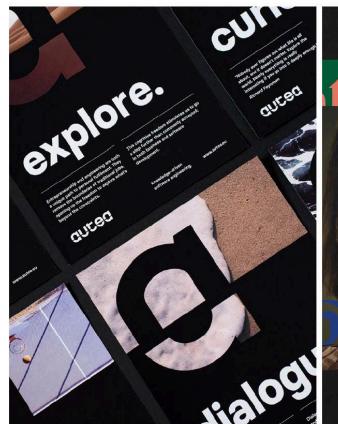
My Role

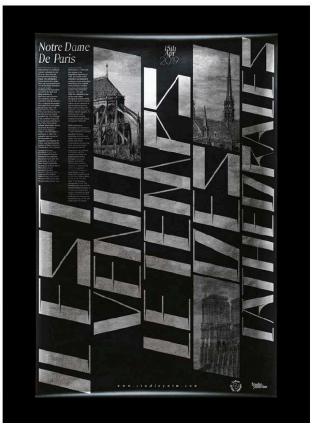
Results

So we prioritised key elements, application rule sets, and libraries to quickly assemble new graphics on the fly at a much faster rate. This also lead to increased variation to prevent staleness without sacraficing brand consistency.

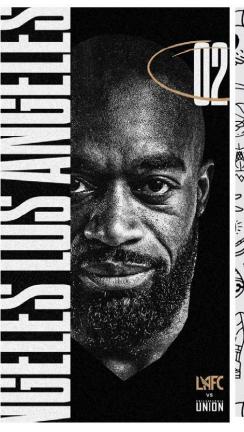

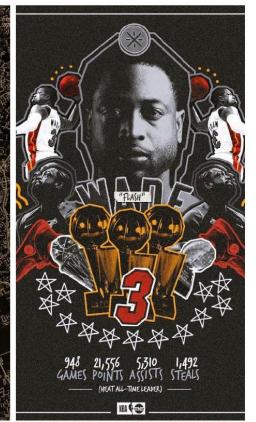

sometimes its really hard to stay that limited. We always run the risk of "looking like the other team" by adding a solid highlight here and there. This black white and silver.



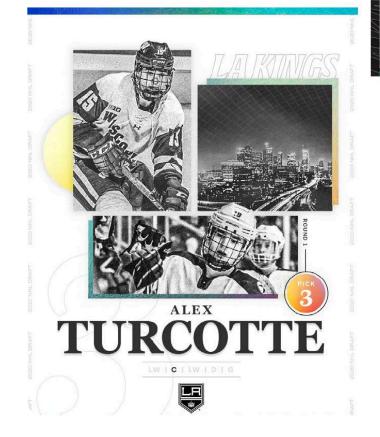

Results

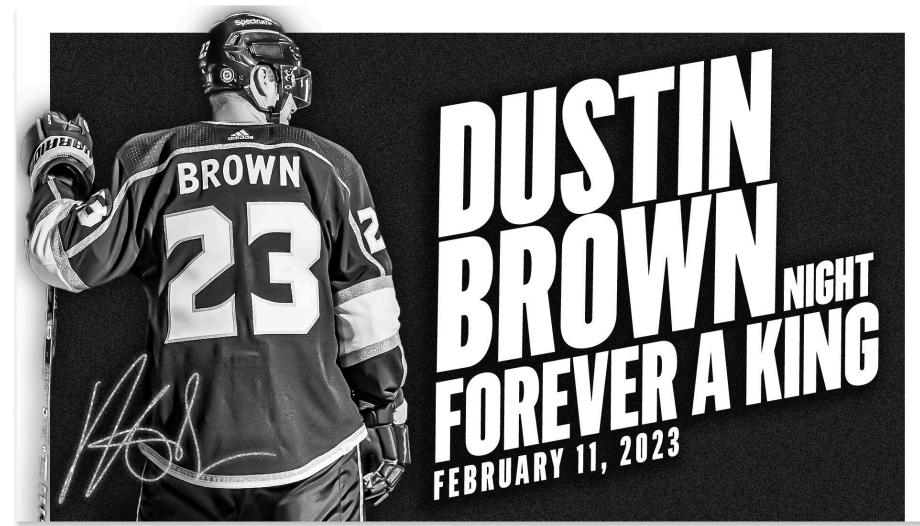

Design and develop an inhouse apparel and hardgoods skate brand that compliments the instore product mix. Evolve and update to maintain relevancy within skate/fashion culture.

Assist the cut and sew team in graphic mood boarding and research. Concepting, hand illustration of graphics, layout, color variations, and pitching. Final art prep and tech pack approved designs.

Results

The Active brand became extremely successful, consistently taking top spots in best sellers across categories. Eventually demand and brand strength was so high that Active began to start distributing their line outside of their own stores to retailers in and outside of the US.

Brief

Redesign the quarterly mail-order catalog to address rising printing costs, which prevent showcasing the full inventory. Current designs feel outdated and bland compared to D2C marketing from carried brands, creating a need for fresh, competitive visuals

My Role

Lead the project each season from start to finish. Concept seasonal theme, print experiments and content pitches, Build and design templates, style guides, photography standards, and editorial sections. Prep and retouch product photography. Pre-press, art delivery, and press checks.

Results

The overhaul saw success on multiple fronts. Showcased product sold through extremely fast, brand support improved, and looks became the go-to style guide of the season. Perhaps the biggest compliment is competitors such as, CCS, Tillys, & Pac Sun all sought to imitate the designs in following seasons.

Our goal was to maximize impact, authenticity, and inspiration. First, we went big, literally. Shrinking the overall page count but increasing the page size to that of a magazine. Less products per page, elevating the imagery and layout in the process. Each season we tried experimenting in print techniques or art styles to truly make each edition feel fresh. Enlisted shop employees and amateur athlete team members for modeling, adding legitimacy to lifestyle imagery. Adding trip blogs and storytelling pages to add context and build aspirational desire. Worked with buyers and merch teams to switch focus to full outfit builds and look book style collections.

Build an umbrella framework that seeks to match target audiences to product mix, marketing, buying, events, and brand development.

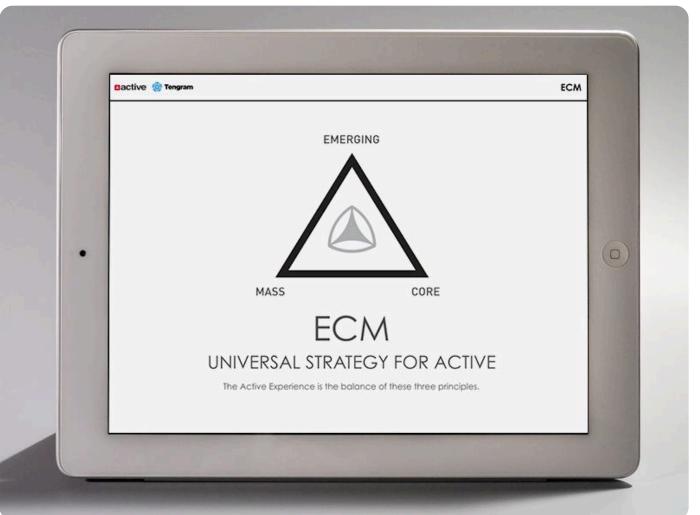
My Role

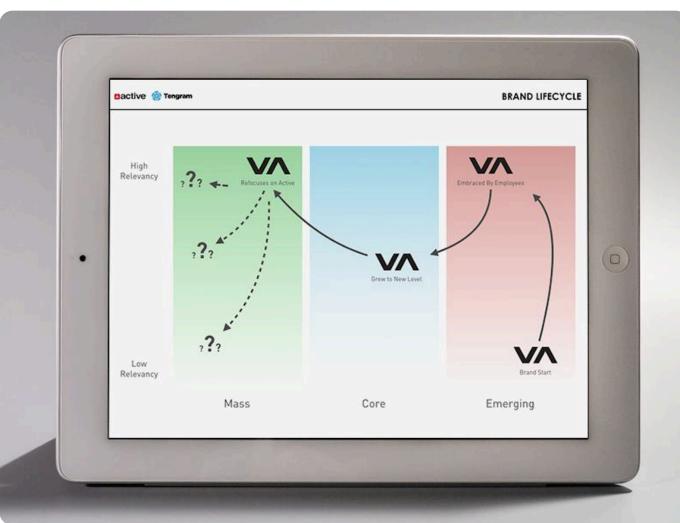

Results

ECM became the ruling guide stone for the company. It provided planning and justification for emerging trends while remaining supportive for foundational revenue. Above everything else the strategy unified communication, goals, and key vocabulary across all departments.

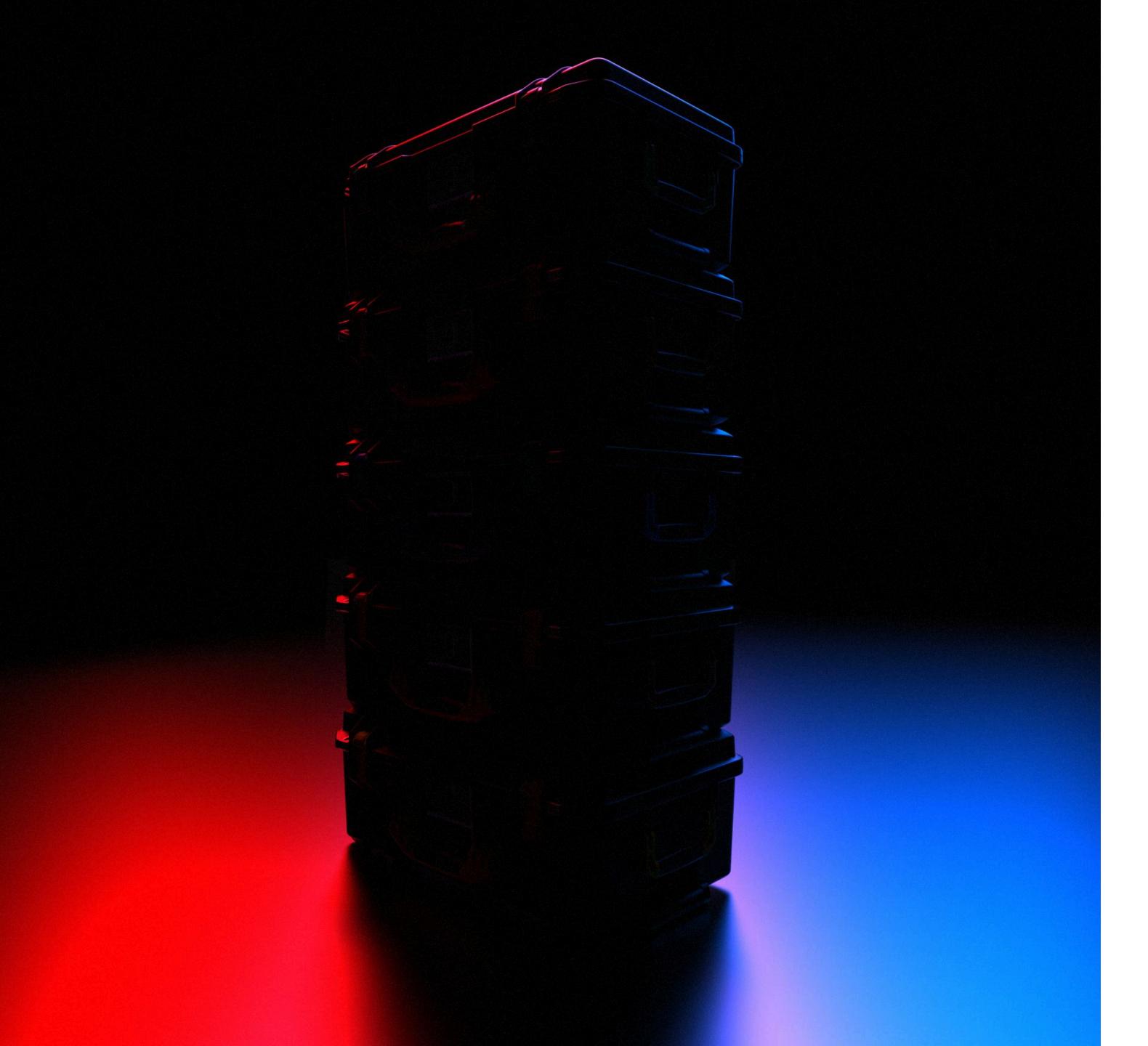

My Role

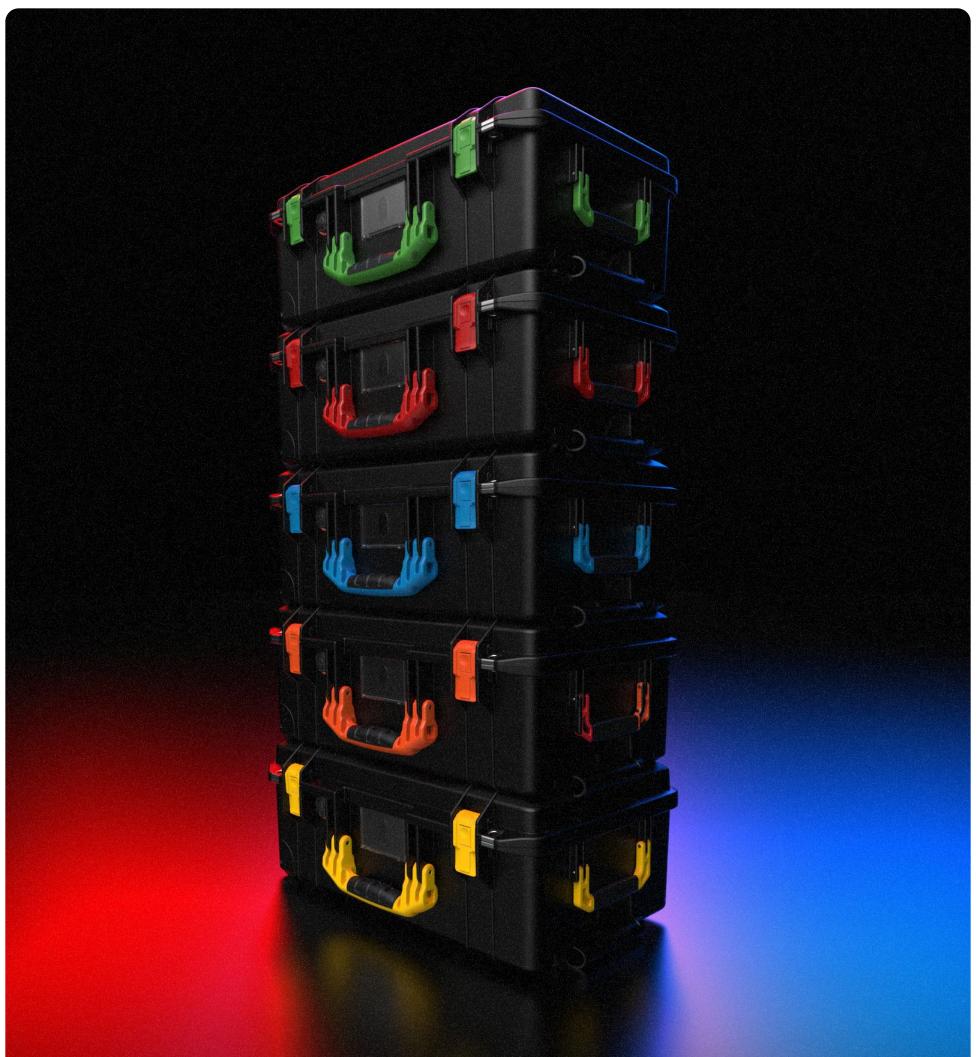
Art direction, lighting and compostion for the campaign.
